- **River Tagus** gave life to the Romans' Olisipo, the Muslims' Al-Ushubna and the capital of the Portuguese Empire,
- 2 **25 de Abril Bridge** opened in 1966 to connect Lisbon to the South Bank.
- 3 **Cristo Rei** National Sanctuary with one of the best views over Lisbon, from the other side of River Tagus.
- Mãe de Água tank for collecting water from the Águas Livres Agueduct built in the 18th century.

- **Vasco da Gama Bridge** it is the most extensive in Europe and one of the longest of the whole wide world.
- 6 **São Jorge Castle** historic stage of the city's occupation since the iron age and of strategic importance to all peoples who inhabited the city.
- Sé, Lisbon Cathedral built in the 12th century by King Afonso Henriques, during the conquest of the city by the Moors, at the site of the old mosque.

- **8 Estrela Basilica** it is the first church in the world dedicated to the worship of the Sacred Heart Jesus, and it's where Queen Mary I is buried.
- 9 Belém Tower architectural jewel of the Manueline style from where the caravels parted to bring new worlds to the world. It was built by King Manuel I in 1514 and is now a world heritage site.
- Monument to the Discoveries erected in 1940 for the Exhibition of the Portuguese World, celebrating the Portuguese discoveries and the prominent personalities of the time.

- Ajuda National Palace former residence of the Portuguese Royal Family after the 1755 earthquake.
- 4 Amoreiras Complex where you can find Amoreiras Shopping Center and Amoreiras 360° Panoramic View sightseeing. It was awarded with the Municipal Architecture Valmor Prize of 1993 and has changed the skyline of the Lisbon City.
